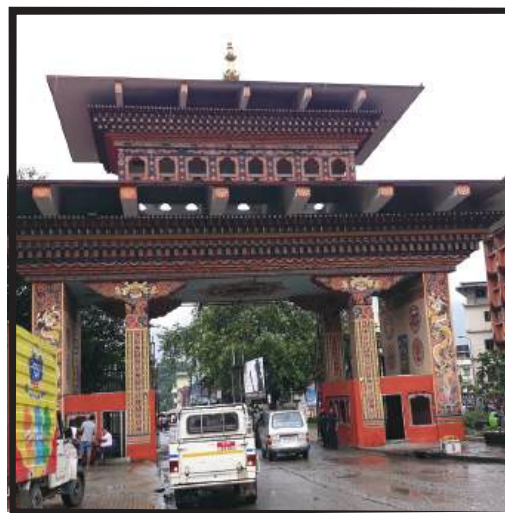
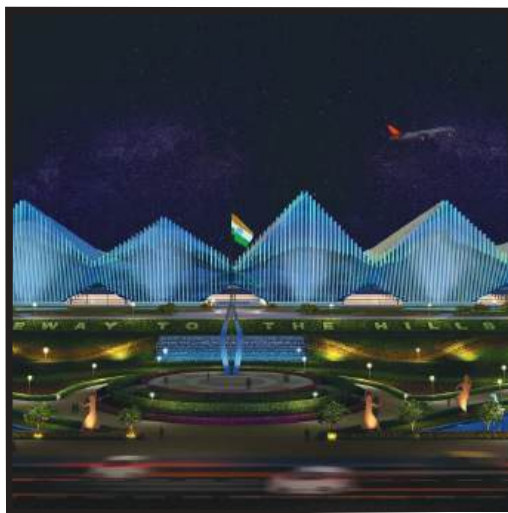

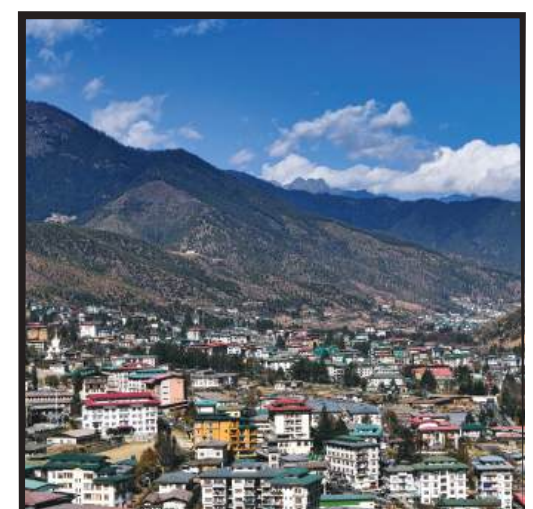
DAY 1 Arrival at Bagdogra – Drive to Phuentsholing

- Overnight stay in Phuentsholing.



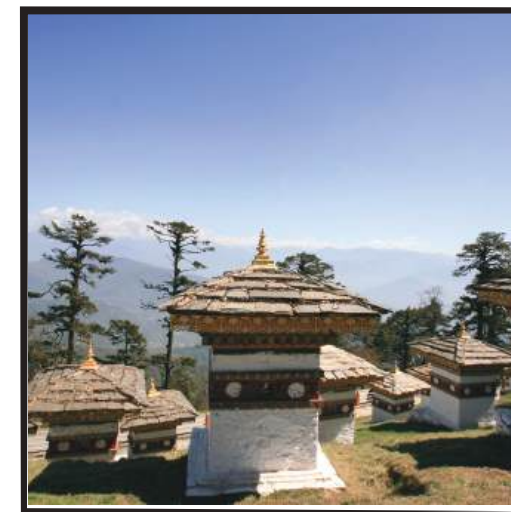
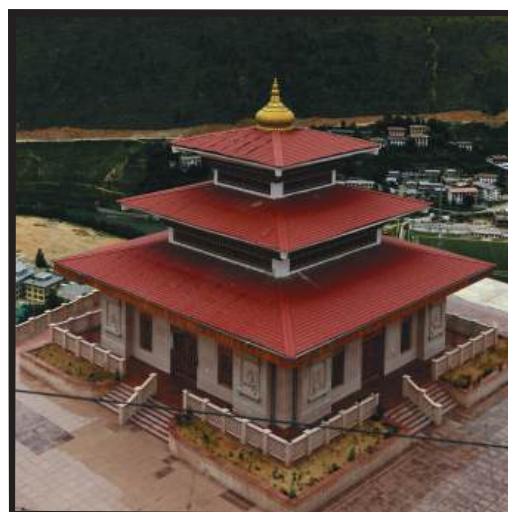
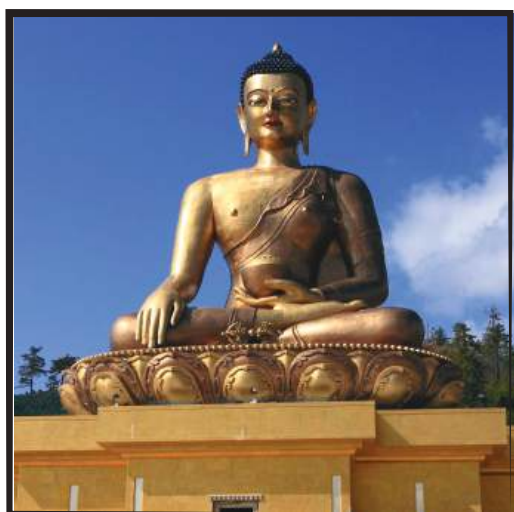
DAY 2 Phuentsholing – Drive to Thimphu

- Stop at the scenic Chhukha Waterfall for photos.
- On arrival in Thimphu, check in at the hotel.
- Overnight stay in Thimphu.



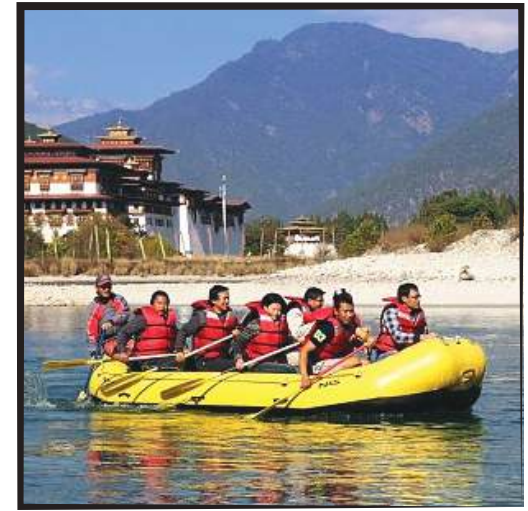
DAY 3 Thimphu Sightseeing to Punakha

- Overnight stay in Punakha.



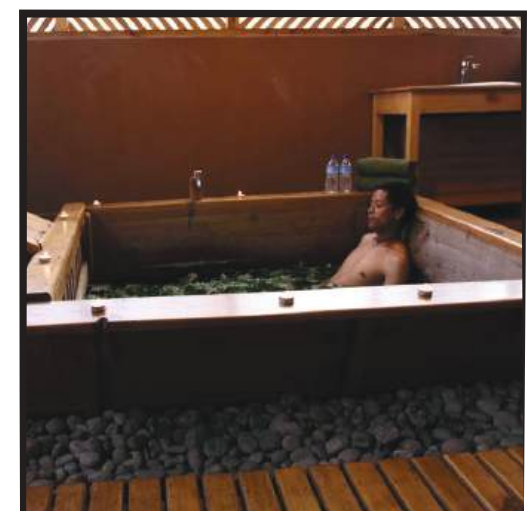
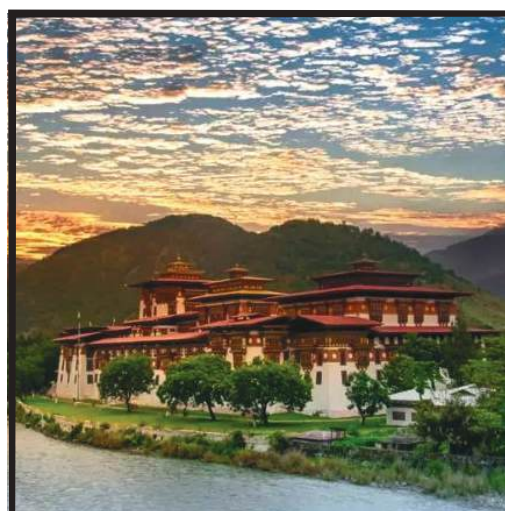
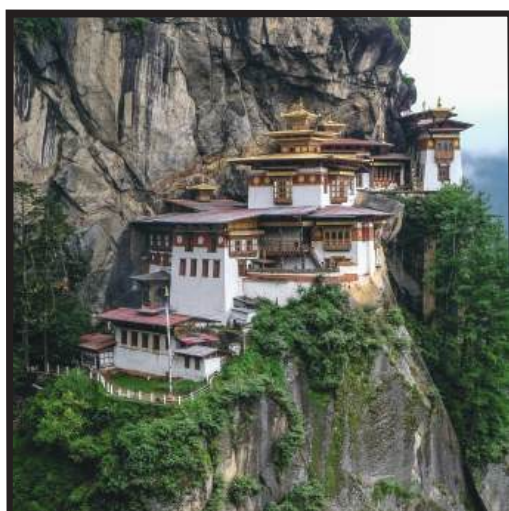
DAY 4 Punakha Sightseeing – Drive to Paro

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the impressive Punakha Dzong, a fine example of Bhutanese architecture.
- Walk across the Punakha Suspension Bridge, one of Bhutan's longest. Optional: Go for river rafting for an adventurous experience (extra cost) Drive to Paro.
- En route, stop at Saba River Point for scenic views.
- On arrival in Paro, check in at the hotel.
- Overnight stay in Paro.



DAY 5 Hike to Taktsang Monastery

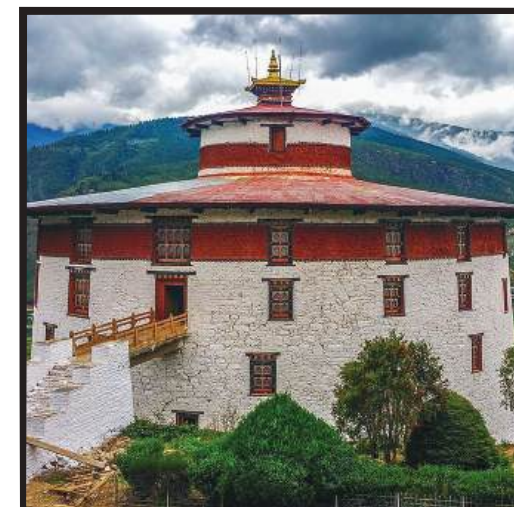
- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Embark on a memorable hike to the iconic Taktsang Monastery (Tiger's Nest), perched dramatically on a cliff 900 m above the valley floor (approx. 5-hour round trip).
- Evening at leisure or optional hot stone bath.

Paro Sightseeing – Drive to Phuentsholing

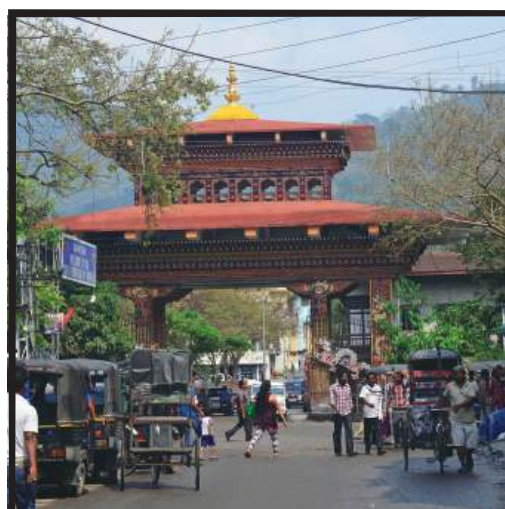
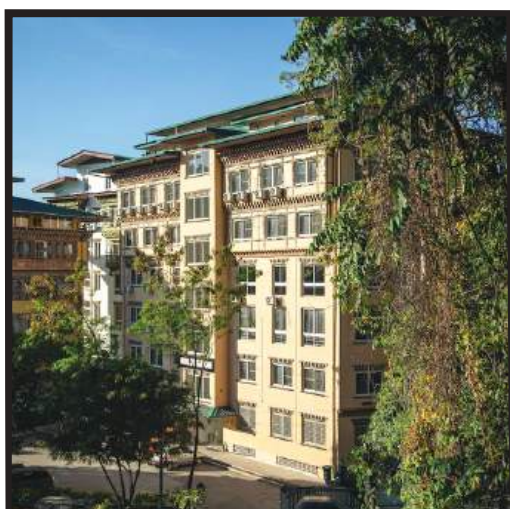
- Breakfast at the hotel.

- On arrival in Phuentsholing, check in at the hotel.
- Overnight stay in Phuentsholing.
